Bucket carriers have many uses:

1. Save wear and tear on your panniers while conditioning your llamas. Buckets can contain sand, gravel, rocks, or water. Water can be easily poured out along the way if llamas are not in good enough condition to complete the hike.
2. Can be used to haul gravel or odd shaped tools for trail maintenance.
3. A great way to haul water when camped away from lakes or streams.
4. With a rope run through the O-rings, can be hung from a tree to keep food safe from bears.



Place a bucket over each white X.

To Load Bucket Carrier:

1. Place a four-gallon square bucket over each X.
2. Pull the 1.5" vertical webbing over the top of the buckets and fasten the buckles with D-rings positioned at top back of buckets.
3. Pull rubber handle up over top of buckets, position 1" buckle exactly between the buckets and close buckle.
4. Buckle horizontal webbing at the front.
5. Tighten and center all webbing for a snug fit.
6. Hang the O-rings from the hooks on a Flaming Star saddle.
7. Adjust the height of the bucket carrier, if necessary, by loosening the 1.5" vertical straps.
8. Lock buckets into place with the lock straps on the saddle.
9. Secure buckets from bouncing by tightening the belly strap that comes with the set.
