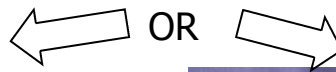

The day-long event is organized by caring volunteers who are active in llama and alpaca rescue who saw the need to educate individuals (who give rescued llamas a home) in the care and training of their camelids. Attendance at Education Day is free to new (and not so new) owners of llamas or alpacas and includes: a local camelid vet discussing general care, a farm insurance presentation, spinning and fiber demonstrations, toenail trimming demo, gelding and teeth trimming demo, shearing demo, discussion on farm layout, gates, feeders, waterers, and nutrition. Workshops are also held on evaluating llamas and saddles for packing, obstacle training, and companion animal certification.
